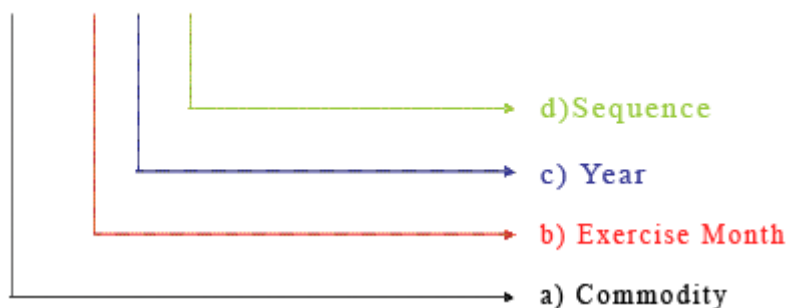


1. Ticker symbol structure

a) Commodity: represented by the first three digits, as follows:

Ticker symbol	Description

CCM	Option on Corn Futures Contract (cash settlement)

DOL	Option on U.S. Dollar Futures Contract

b) Contract month: represented by the fourth digit, in accordance with the international standard:

F=	January	G=	February	H=	March
J=	April	K=	May	M=	June
N=	July	Q=	August	U=	September
V=	October	X=	November	Z=	December

- c) Year:** represented by an alphanumeric symbol, with the exclusion of all vowels as well as of consonant Z, thereby resulting in 30 years, as follows:

From the 2030 onwards, the sequence restarts with digit 0, followed by 1 (2031), 2 (2032), 3 (2033), ..., 7 (2037), 8 (2038), 9 (2039), B (2040), C (2041) and so on.

- d) Sequence:** represented by two alphanumeric symbols. The first symbol in the sequence represents the option type, as follows:

Options on Actuals	
American-style call	0, 1, 2 or 3
American-style put	4, 5, 6 or 7
European-style call	8, 9, B or C
European-style put	D, F, G or H
Options on Futures	
American-style call	I, J, K or L

American-style put	M, N, P or Q
European-style call	R, S, T or V
European-style put	W, X, Y or Z

The second symbol of the sequence could be a letter or a number, as shown below, which will represent the series number, thereby allowing multiple combinations.

D12N9RQ	European-style call option on U.S Dollar futures; expiration date of July 2009
BGIK9MN	American-style call option on live cattle futures; expiration date of May 2009
ICFU9IH	American-style call option on Arabica coffee futures; expiration date of September 2009
